

## Fitness Activity Tracking – Fitness Summary Widget

raisin’s Peer-to-Peer (Pledge and Multi-Pledge) fundraising modules support Fitness Activity Tracking, which empowers fundraisers to connect their personal fundraising page and team page to their Strava fitness tracking app. When exercise is recorded on Strava, it is synced back their fundraising page(s), displaying Distance and Time, and their five most recent activities.

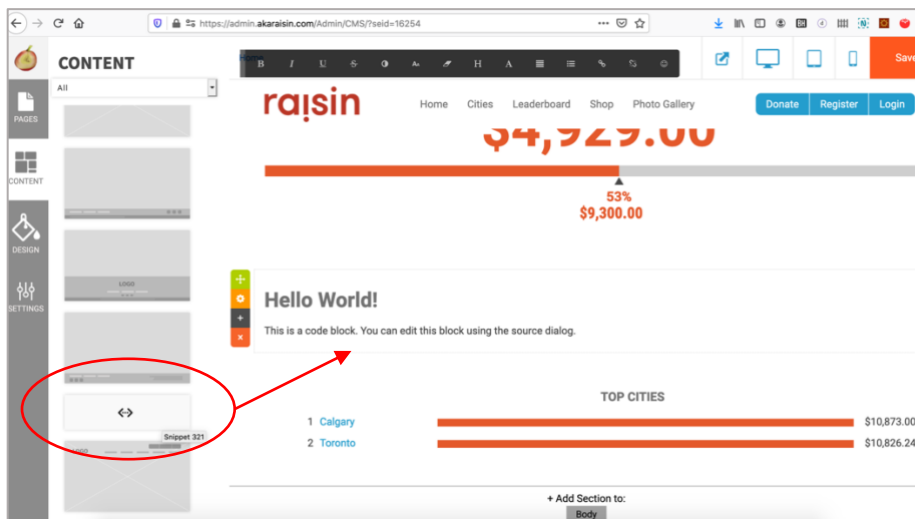
To support cumulative Event challenges, we’ve developed a “Fitness Summary Widget” that tallies all activity recorded in the event and can be dropped into any page built through the raisin Website CMS. The widget updates in real-time as updates are received from Strava.

### Step 1: Decide on a page

In a Peer-to-Peer event, decide on the page where you’d like to place the Fitness Summary Widget.

### Step 2: Drag and drop a Code content block into Page

From the **Content** panel, choose “All” from the drop-down menu of Content selections. Scroll to the bottom, to find the Code Content block, or Snippet 321. Drag this block into the area you’d like the Summary Widget to live. It can be moved later, if you wish.



### Step 3: Paste the Fitness Summary code snippet

Click the yellow Gear icon in the Code block you’ve just added. A pop-up will appear with sample code. Delete it, and replace it with the following code snippet:

#### Step 4: Customize event details and styles

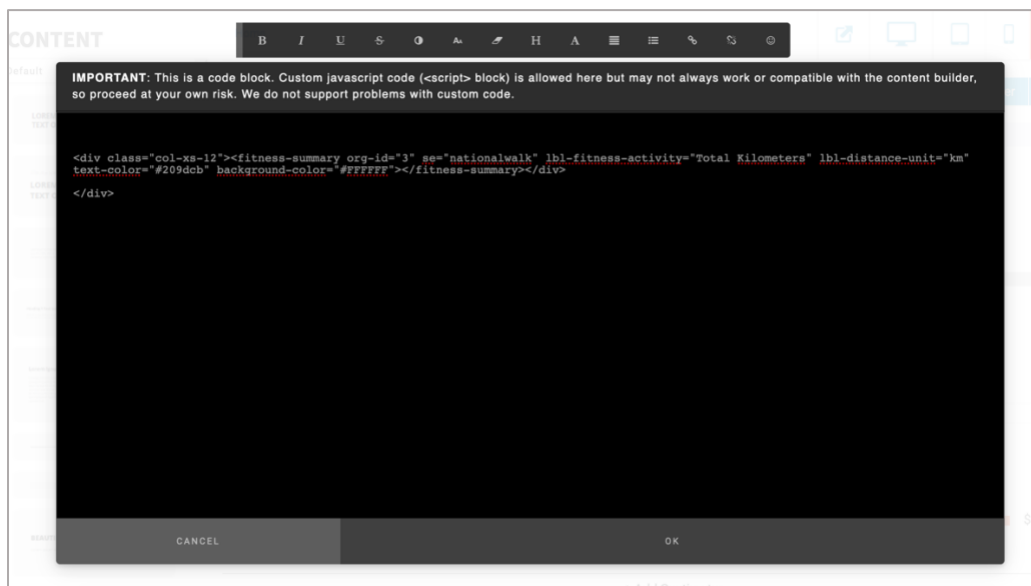
The snippet represents the Fitness Summary widget. To customize it, you'll need to update it with details about your event and/or brand by placing values into the array. You can set the following parameters:

Parameter	Description	Example
<b>org-id</b>	Your unique raisin Organization ID.	"3"
<b>se</b>	Custom Page URL of the Event created in Event/Location Details.	"nationalwalk"
<b>lbl-fitness-activity</b>	Title of the Widget. Appears above statistic.	"Fitness Activity"
<b>lbl-distance-unit</b>	Label for distance. <b>Note:</b> This changes the label, but not the calculation of Distance. All US organizations tally distance in miles, Canadian organization is kilometers.	"km" or "mi"
<b>text-color</b>	Color of text in the widget. Accepts any hex color.	"#000000"
<b>background-color</b>	Color of background behind statistic.	"#FFFFFF"
<b>show-time</b>	Shows Time (h and min) instead of Distance	"true"

*For example: Organization ID 3 is creating a summary widget for a Peer-to-Peer walk in Canada with a Custom Page URL of "nationalwalk". The organization is setting the title text to read "Total Kilometers" and in blue, and against a white background. The widget would be created with the following parameters:*

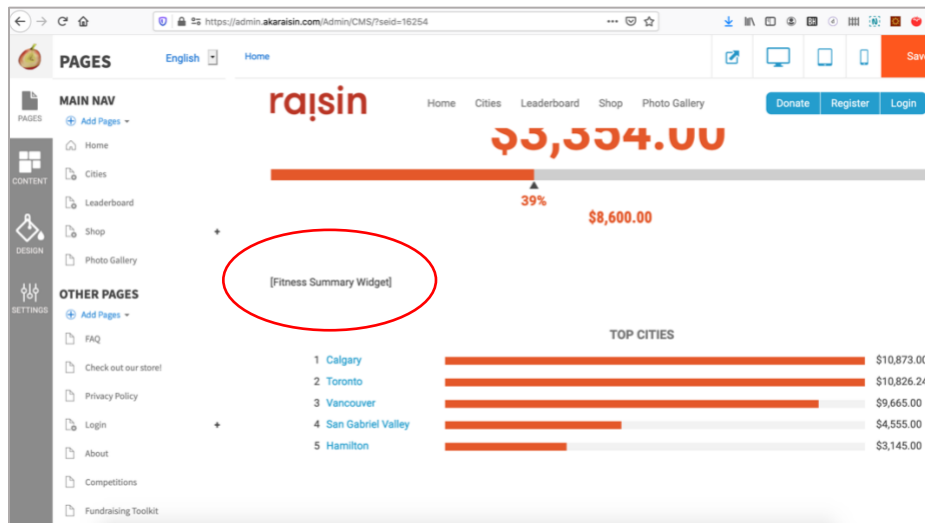
The snippet you define is then pasted into the Code block:



Click “OK” to close the pop-up.

In the Preview panel, a placeholder reading [Fitness Summary Widget] will appear where it’s been placed. Save your changes.

**Note:** While the placeholder is left-aligned, the widget will automatically center into the region it’s placed on the front-end.



**Step 5: Showcase your fundraisers fitness activity!**

You’re done! Click to view the live site, and a new widget tallying the total Fitness Activity performed in the event will appear where you’ve placed it.
